Tom Largey, resident, questioned why the Borough bases their sewer bills off of water usage rather than charging a flat rate like a lot of the surrounding towns. Administrator Verruni stated that is not that uncommon - he previously worked in Wall Township and Ventnor and both based their billing off of usage – and is self-liquidating public utility – we do not gain revenue from it – the rates need to cover the cost of running the utility. Councilman Bieber suggested Mr. Largey look into installing a deduct meter at his residence – it significantly lowers your sewer bill due to outdoor water usage.
